- 1. The two Educational Institutions will:
- a) Co-operate in the exchange of information relating to their activities in teaching and research in fields of mutual interests.
- b) Promote appropriate joint research projects and joint courses of study, with particular emphasis on internationally funded projects.
- c) Endeavor to encourage students and staff to spend periods of time in the host University. The exchange of students all is dependent on the execution of a formal Student Exchange Agreement prior to commencement of this activity.
- d) Conduct short courses, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.
- e) Conduct cultural projects, a, mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.
- f) Conduct study tours, a, mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.
- g) Exchange of teaching faculty to share knowledge on concerned subjects, academic members of staff and other personnel of one partner institution may spend periods in the other partner institution.
- h) The aim of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both Universities.

Each of the above modes of interaction will be initiated by entering into a separate agreement between the two parties.
