

### **MANAGEMENT**

Driven by his unwavering belief that the socio-economic progress of the nation rests on the foundation of quality education, Sri. A. Krishnappa dedicated himself to making education accessible to all. Recognizing the challenges faced by bright and talented students from socially and economically underprivileged backgrounds, he established this institution with the noble vision of providing affordable, high-quality education to empower such vulnerable sections of society.

Today, the S.E.A. Group comprises 10 institutions, including State and ICSE schools, Pre-University and Degree Colleges, a School of Management, Teacher Training Institutes, Nursing, Law, and Engineering colleges. Operating under the umbrella of the S.E.A. Education Trust, these institutions collectively offer a comprehensive range of educational opportunities, spanning from kindergarten to postgraduate and research programs, all of which continue to thrive and uphold the founder's enduring legacy.

#### **COURSES OFFERED**

The college was assessed and accredited with a 'B' Grade during its first cycle by NAAC in 2018. Following the submission of the Self-Study Report, preparations are underway for the renewal of accreditation for the second cycle for the year 2023.

Over the years, the institution has experienced significant growth with the introduction of multidisciplinary undergraduate programs. The college enjoys permanent affiliation for various courses, including B. Com (General), B. (Psychology, Forensic Science, Clinical Nutrition and dietetics Electronics & Communication), and BCA, all of which are affiliated with Bangalore North University. Furthermore, these courses are recognized under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956.

The college also offers a range of postgraduate programs in Commerce, Management, and Science, including M.Sc., MCA, MBA, M. Com, MA, and MSW and MTTM, all affiliated with Bangalore North University.

To enhance the learning experience and equip students with industry-relevant skills, the curriculum is complemented by value-added courses such as Advanced Excel, Digital Marketing, Tally, Robotics, Android, and Python. Additionally, professional certification programs like ACCA, offered in collaboration with ISDC, aim to provide students with advanced skills tailored to meet industrial demands. Founded with a modest beginning, offering fewer than four courses and a student strength in the two digits, S.E.A College of Science, Commerce, and Arts has witnessed remarkable growth and transformation.
