



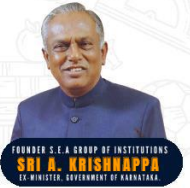

RURAL LEARNING CAMP BY MSW



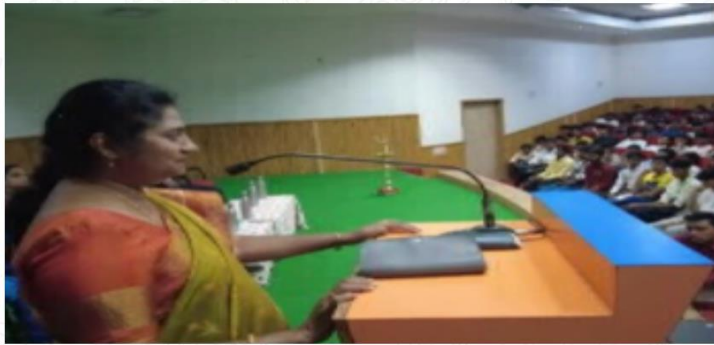
