INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO GOA STATE FORENSIC SCIENCE LABORATORY

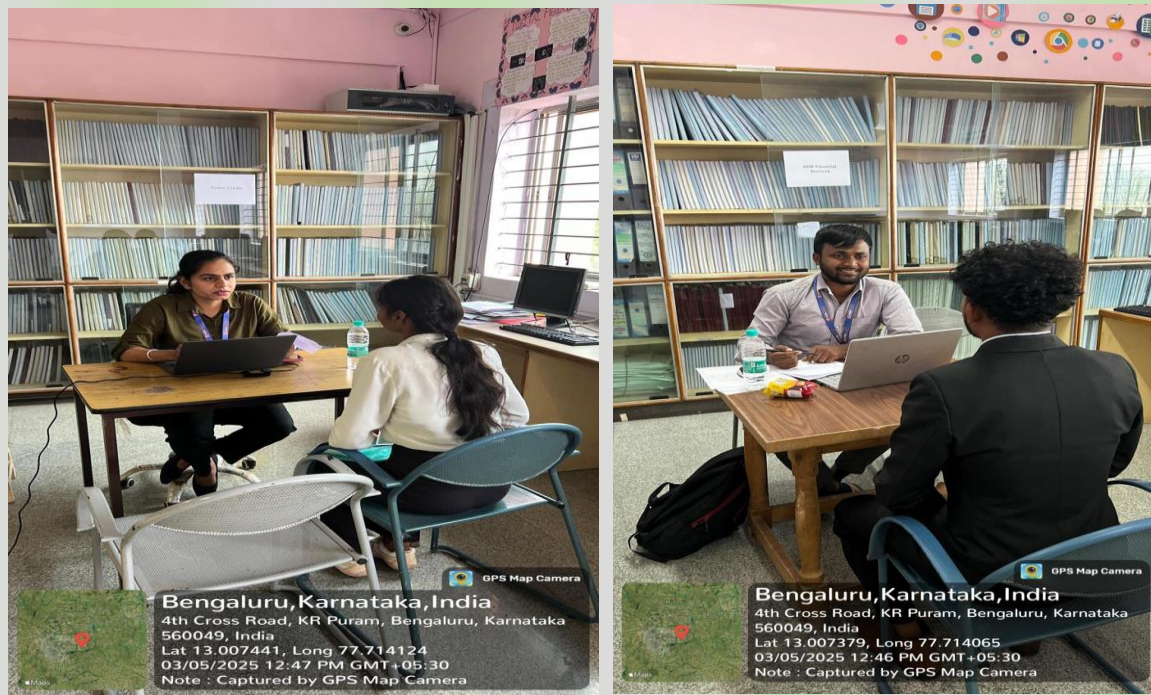

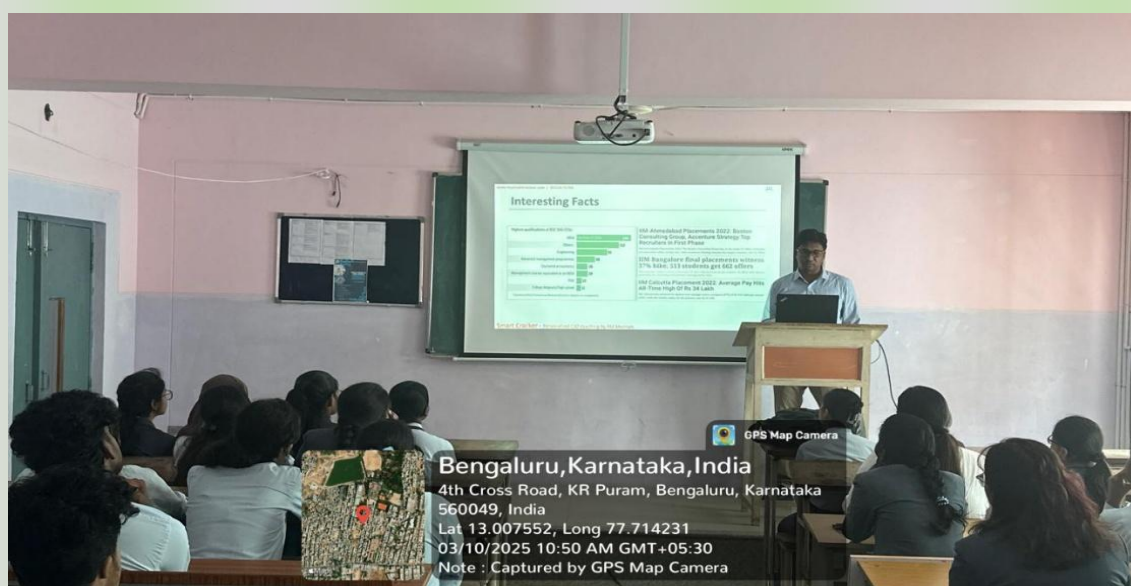




EXPERT TALK ON CAREER PATHWAYS

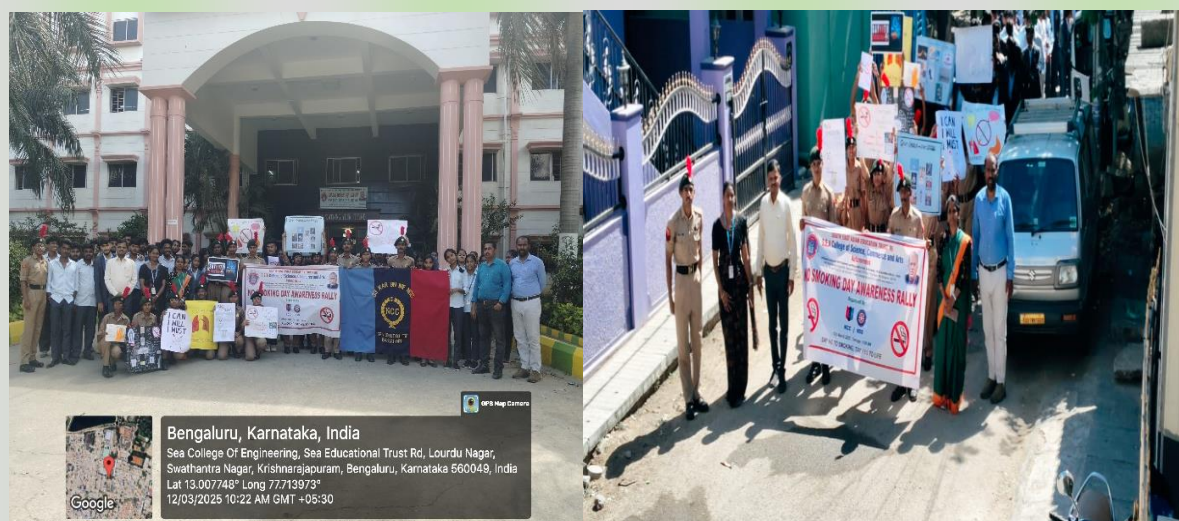


NO SMOKING DAY 2025: A STEP TOWARDS A HEALTHIER FUTURE

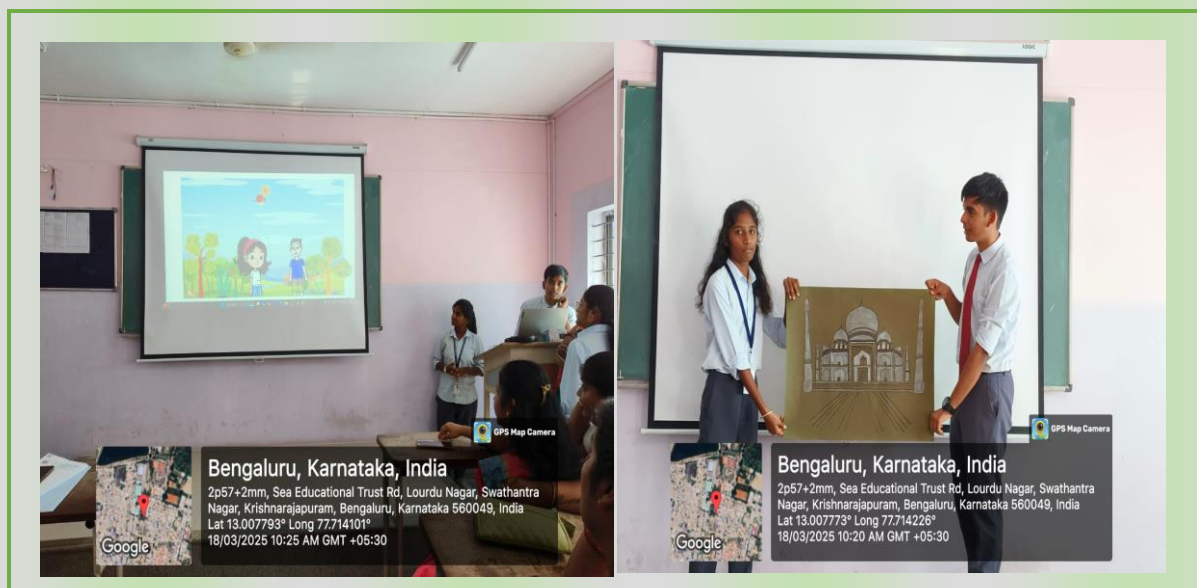
