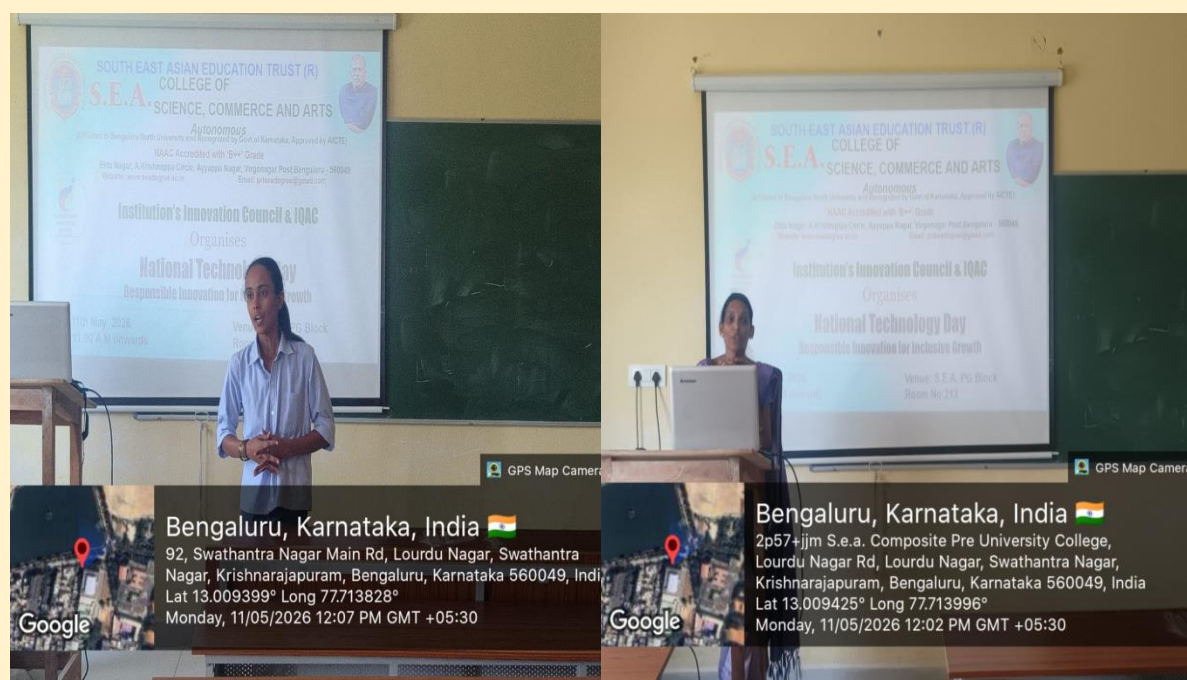

BOARD OF STUDIES MEETINGS FOR BBA, MBA, BCA & MCA

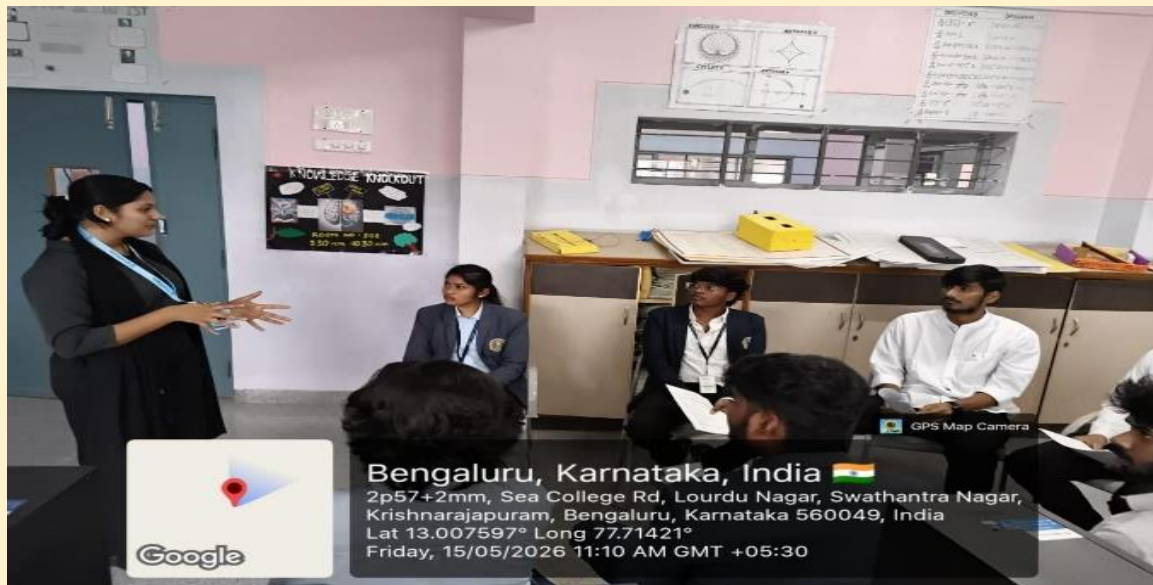
