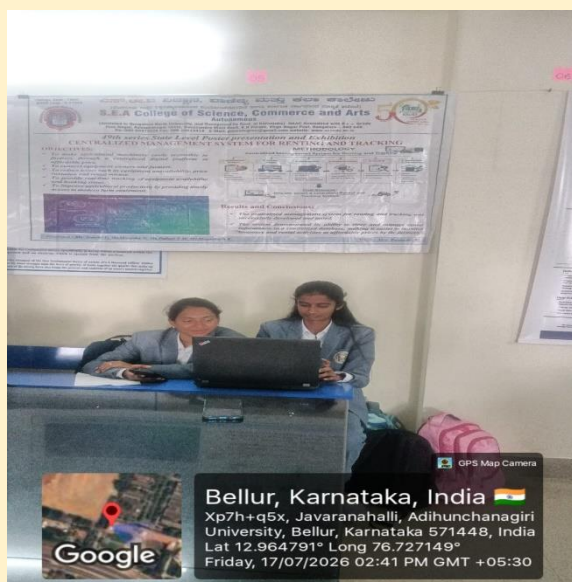

MCA STUDENTS SHOWCASE INNOVATION AT STATE LEVEL POSTER PRESENTATION

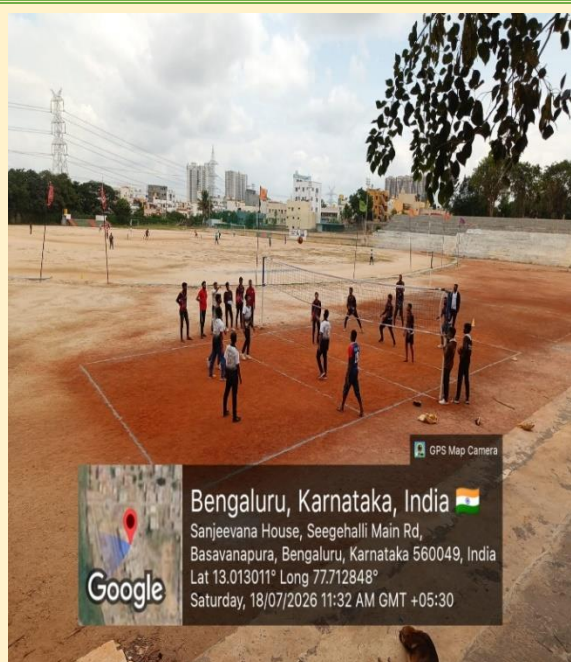

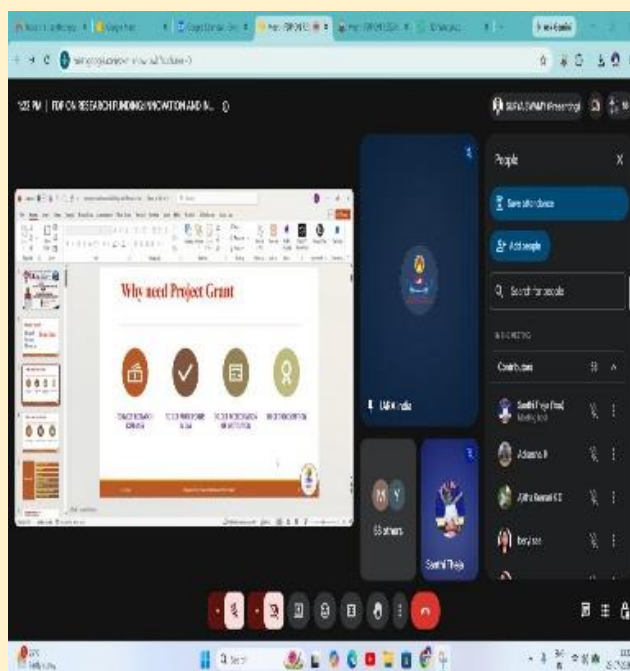

Day Four

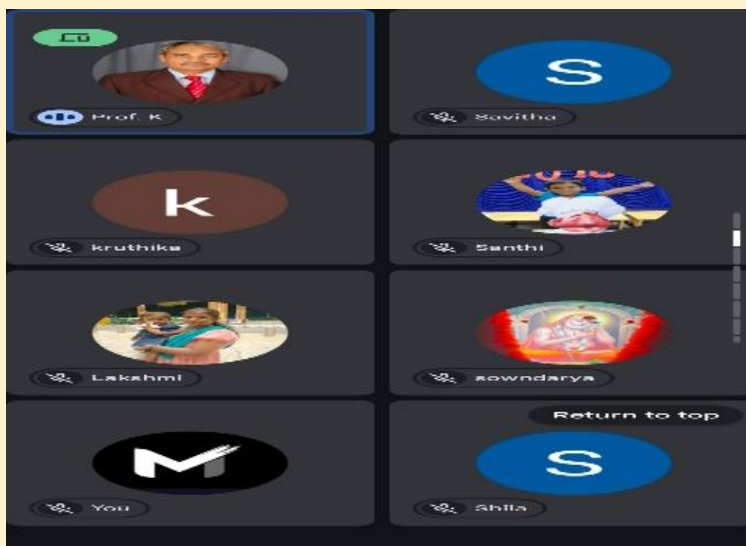
